

# VOTING RECORD

YOUR LEGISLATORS' VOTING RECORD ON SMALL BUSINESS ISSUES

**2007–2008 SESSION:** Roll call votes by your state legislators on the following key small business issues during the 123rd Maine Legislature are listed inside. Although this *Voting Record* does not reflect all elements or votes considered by a lawmaker during the two-year session, nor does it represent a complete profile of a legislator, it can be a guide in evaluating your legislator's attitude toward small business on the issues presented in this document. Please also remember, many issues that affected small businesses did not receive a roll call vote. Please thank those legislators who supported small business and start a conversation with those whose votes were not considered supportive.

**1.** Dirigo Health Self-Administration (LD 431): Allows Dirigo Health to self-insure instead of contracting with a health insurance company, thus allowing competition with private insurers. Among other things, effectively exempts the program from state insurance laws with which private insurers must still comply, thus giving the program a potential advantage over private insurers. **A "No" vote supports the NFIB position.** Passed 18–17 in the Senate; passed 84–56 in the House. (2007)

**2.** Regulation Impact Analysis (LD 905): Requires state agencies to prepare an economic impact statement on proposed rules that may have an adverse effect on small businesses. **A "Yes" vote supports the NFIB position.** Passed 141–0 in the House; no recorded vote in the Senate. (2007)

**3.** Retail Personal Property Tax Fairness (LD 1001): Would have made small retail establishments—those with less than 20,000 square feet of interior retail space—eligible for the Business Equipment Tax Exemption (BETE) program, thus eliminating the need for affected firms to pay the personal property tax on eligible

equipment. Retail establishments continue to be eligible for the Business Equipment Tax Reimbursement (BETR) program, which requires payment of the tax and application to the state for reimbursement. **A "Yes" vote supports the NFIB position.** Passed 29–4 in the Senate; passed 139–0 in the House. Died on the Appropriations table for lack of funding. (2008)

**4.** Health Insurance Market Regulation (LD 1294): Among other things, would have made it easier to contest rate increases in the individual and small employer markets, thus effectively making it more difficult and costly for insurers to obtain rate increases and do business in Maine. **A "Yes" vote in the Senate and "No" vote in the House support the NFIB position.** Defeated 25–10 in the Senate; passed 85–58 in the House. (2008)

**5.** Paid Sick Leave (LD 1454): Would have required all employers with 25 or more employees to provide a minimum of one hour of paid sick leave for every 30 hours worked, up to a maximum of 72 hours or nine days a year, for full-time and part-time workers. **A "Yes" vote supports**

**the NFIB position to reject the measure.** Defeated 79–59 in the House. (2008)

**6.** Minimum Wage Increase (LD 1697): Raises the minimum wage to \$7.25 in October 2008, and to \$7.50 in October 2009, and also removes exemptions for domestic service providers, public and educational nonprofit employees, and workers in hotels, motels, restaurants and other eating establishments. (State labor officials say these exemption changes will have minimal impact.) **A "No" vote supports the NFIB position.** Passed 18–17 in the Senate; passed 77–65 in the House. (2008)

**7.** Tax Reform—Sales Tax on Services (LD 1925): Would have increased taxes by about \$253 million to pay for reduced income (\$195 million) and property taxes (\$41 million). The tax increases included expanding the sales tax to dozens of personal, installation, repair, property, amusement, transportation and other services. Other tax increases included raising the meals and lodging tax, doubling the beer and wine excise tax, and significantly increasing the real estate transfer tax. **A "No" vote supports the NFIB position.**

Passed 80–59 in the House; defeated 7–28 in the Senate. (2007)

**8.** Implied Warranty Posting (LD 2143): Would have required retailers, other than auto dealers, who sell service contracts (regardless of retailer or store size) to post a notice that makes customers clearly aware of the state’s

implied warranty law. **A “No” vote supports the NFIB position.** Passed 75–66 in the House; defeated 15–19 in the Senate. (2008)

**9.** Dirigo Health Funding—New Taxes (LD 2247): Establishes new funding sources for the Dirigo Health program, including replacement of the

4 percent surcharge on insurance premiums with a 1.8 percent surcharge on health claims. For distributors or manufacturers, the tax on beer and wine more than doubles. A new tax is also imposed on soft drinks and syrup used in flavored drinks. **A “No” vote supports the NFIB position.** Passed 18–17 in the Senate; passed 72–69 in the House. (2008)
