YOUR LEGISLATORS' VOTING RECORD ON SMALL BUSINESS ISSUES

2007–2008 SESSION: Roll call votes by your state legislators on NFIB officially state-balloted legislation during the 2007–2008 session of the South Carolina General Assembly are outlined below. Although this *Voting Record* does not reflect all elements considered by a lawmaker when voting, nor does it represent a complete profile of a legislator, it can be a guide in evaluating your legislator's attitude toward small business. Remember, many issues that would have affected small business did not go to a roll call vote in either the House or Senate. No percentage was computed for the senators because of the limited number of roll call votes on NFIB agenda items; however, three key votes by your senator are included. HOUSE VOTES:

1. Workers' Compensation Reform (S.332): The bill revises the state's workers' compensation system, which pays disability benefits and necessary medical expenses for workers who sustain injuries in the course of their employment. The legislation contains provisions geared toward combating workers' compensation fraud, such as penalties for fraud and elimination of the Second Injury Fund. A motion was made to pass the bill on second reading. A **"Yes" vote supports the NFIB position.** The motion passed the House 110–0. Having been approved by the General Assembly, S.332 (R.163) was signed into law (Act No. 111) by the governor on June 25, 2007.

2. South Carolina Department of Transportation Restructuring (H.3575): This legislation provided for comprehensive revisions to the governance and operation of the Department of Transportation. A proposed amendment to H.3575, offered by Rep. B.R. Skelton, raised the gas tax to 21 cents a gallon and

reduced the sales and use tax on unprepared food purchased with USDA food coupons from 3 percent to 1 percent. All revenue of the 1 percent sales and use tax would have been credited to the Education Improvement Act of 1984 Fund. The vote was to table the amendment. A **"Yes" vote supports the NFIB position.** The amendment was tabled 74–36. Legislation died.

3. Small Employer Health Group Cooperative (S.588): This bill establishes the requirements, powers, duties and restrictions for a small employer health group cooperative. The legislation enhances the authority for small employers to form cooperatives for the purpose of providing lower health insurance costs to their employees. Motion was to give the bill second reading. A **"Yes" vote supports the NFIB position.** The motion passed 105–0. Having passed the Senate and the House, S.588 was ratified on Feb. 13, 2008 (R.189) and signed into law by the governor on Feb. 19 (Act No. 180).

4. South Carolina Capital Improvements Sales and Use Tax

(H.4883): The bill establishes the South Carolina Capital Improvements Sales and Use Tax Act, which would have expanded the ability of local governments to impose sales and use taxes for the purpose of generating revenue for school construction, to include the construction and improvement of institutions of higher education. The vote was to give the bill a second reading. A **"No" vote supports the NFIB position.** The bill passed the House by a vote of 59–25. On the Senate side, H.4883 was never passed out of the Senate Finance Committee.

5. New Energy Conservation Goals for State Agencies (H.4766): The legislation establishes new energy conservation goals for state agencies, designed to reduce energy consumption by at least 1 percent annually for five consecutive years. The plan also must have a goal of ultimately reducing energy consumption by 20 percent by July 1, 2020, relative to year 2000 levels. Motion was to give the bill a second reading. A **"Yes" vote supports the NFIB position.** The motion passed by a vote of 108–0. Having passed the House and the Senate (R.389), H.4766 was signed into law by the governor on June 11, 2008.

6. Fire Sprinkler System Tax Credits (H.4470): This bill authorizes tax credits and exemptions to encourage the installation of fire sprinkler systems in commercial and residential structures. A **"Yes" vote supports the NFIB position.** Having passed the House and the Senate, H.4470 was ratified on June 5, 2008 (R.385). The governor vetoed the legislation on June 11. On June 25, the House and

the Senate overrode the veto (109-0 in the House) to allow the bill to become law.

SENATE VOTES:

1. Workers' Compensation Reform (S.332): The bill revises the state's workers' compensation system, which pays disability benefits and necessary medical expenses for workers who sustain injuries in the course of their employment. The legislation contains provisions geared toward combating workers' compensation fraud. A motion was made to give the bill a third reading. **A "Yes" vote supports the NFIB position.** The motion passed 33-7. Having been approved by the General Assembly,

S.332 (R.163) was signed into law (Act No. 111) by the governor on June 25, 2007.

2. State Spending Caps (S.718): The joint resolution would have amended the South Carolina Constitution to limit state spending to the prior 10 years' average revenue growth rate. The motion was for the bill to receive a second reading. **A "Yes" vote supports the NFIB position.** The motion passed 30-14. Debate adjourned.

3. Fire Sprinkler System Tax Credits (H.4470): This bill authorizes tax credits and exemptions to encourage the installation of fire sprinkler systems in

commercial and residential structures. **A "Yes" vote supports the NFIB position.** Having passed the House and the Senate, H.4470 was ratified on June 5, 2008 (R.385). The governor vetoed the legislation on June 11. On June 25, the House and the Senate overrode the veto (43-0 in the Senate) to allow the bill to become law.
