

VOTING RECORD YOUR LEGISLATORS' VOTING RECORD ON SMALL BUSINESS ISSUES 2016 EDITION

2015 - 2016 SESSIONS: Roll call votes on the floor by state legislators on those issues where NFIB had an official position are listed below. The Voting Record is only one measure of a legislator's performance and cannot reflect all elements or every deliberation considered by a legislator when casting a particular vote. Many issues affecting small business are decided in committees and never make it to the floor of the House or Senate. The Voting Record does not indicate which legislators represented small business interests in committees or behind the scenes, nor does it represent a complete profile of a legislator. The Voting Record can serve as a guide in evaluating a legislator's understanding of the issues important to small business. Please take the time to thank those legislators who supported NFIB efforts to promote and protect the rights of our members to own, operate and grow their businesses, and continue to work with those who have fallen short.

- Biennial State Budget & Tax Package (2015, HB-7061): Appropriates \$40.2 billion in state spending and contains \$1.3 billion in tax and fee increases on businesses and individuals, including an extension of the corporate tax surcharge, an increase in marginal individual income tax rates, the reduction of net operating loss carry-forwards and a reduction in the property tax credit and various sales tax changes. A "No" vote supports the NFIB position. Passed the House 73-70-8. Passed the Senate 19-17.
- 2. Small Business Regulatory Impact Statements (2016, SB-302): Expands the type of information state agencies must include as part of their regulatory flexibility analysis before adopting regulations that directly affect small business. A "Yes" vote supports the NFIB position. Passed the Senate 36-0. Passed the House 143-0-8. Vetoed by the Governor. Veto overridden and repassed by the legislature.
- 3. Entrepreneur Learner's Permit (2016, SB-303): Establishes an Entrepreneur Learner's Permit program to encourage and assist first-time business owners in certain sectors by reimbursing them for state fees associated with forming a business. A "Yes" vote supports the NFIB position. Passed the House 145-0-5. Passed the Senate 36-0.
- 4. Regulatory Review Process (2016, **HB-5498):** Makes revisions to the regulatory review process to clarify timing and responsibility for conducting reviews of existing state agency regulations. A "Yes" vote supports the NFIB position. Passed the House 146-0-4. Passed the Senate 36-0.
- 5. State Run Retirement Plan (2016, HB-5591): Creates the Connecticut Retirement Security Authority, a quasi-public agency, to establish a program of Roth individual retirement accounts for eligible

- private-sector employees at businesses with five or more employees that do not otherwise offer a qualified retirement plan. The legislation provides that eligible employees will be automatically enrolled in the plan at a rate of between 3 percent and 6 percent of wages unless they opt out and requires employers to enroll and remit contributions on behalf of participating employees, among other provisions. A "No" vote supports the NFIB position. Passed the House 76-63-11. Passed the Senate 18-18, following the Lieutenant Governor casting the deciding vote in favor.
- 6. Biennial State Budget Revisions (2016, **SB-501):** Makes revisions to the previously passed (2015 session) biennial state budget for fiscal year 2017 without including significant structural budgetary changes. Increases spending from previous fiscal year and relies on enhanced tax collections, estimated payments from lawsuit settlements and other singular revenue sources and fund sweeps resulting in projected state budget deficits of over \$1.3 billion and \$1.5 billion into each of the next two fiscal years. A "No" vote supports the NFIB position. Passed the House 74-70-7. Passed the Senate 21-15.
- 7. Credit Report Restrictions (2015, HB-6789): Limits the circumstances under which an employer may require a job applicant or an employee to consent to a credit report by eliminating the nonfinancial assets value exception under the law. A "No" vote supports the NFIB position. Passed the House 133-13-5.
- 8. Credit Report Restrictions (2016, SB-40): Limits the circumstances under which an employer may require a job applicant or an employee to consent to a credit report by increasing the threshold for the nonfinancial assets value exception under the law. A "No" vote supports the NFIB position. Passed the Senate 26-10.
