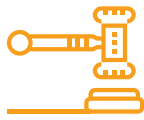

(Environmental and Labor Cases)



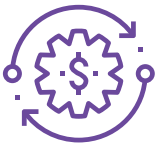

Judge Merrick Garland has served as a judge on the D.C. Court of Appeals since 1997, where he has decided over 150 cases on regulatory issues. In those cases, he rarely sided with business. In cases against the federal government, that amounts to a 90 percent win-rate for government over business.

If appointed to the Supreme Court, his decisions on important, upcoming cases like the EPA Waters of the U.S. Rule, the EPA Clean Power Plan, and the NLRB Ambush Election Rule, could cripple small business.
