Register

October 15, 2024: Deadline to register to vote.

*Voters may register to vote at early voting sites or on Election Day.

Voting

All registered voters may vote absentee either by mail or early in-person at their local registrar's office. Voters can apply for an absentee ballot online using the Citizen Portal.

September 20, 2024: In-person absentee voting begins.

October 25, 2024: Deadline to request an absentee ballot by mail.

November 2, 2024: In-person absentee voting ends. Deadline to request an in-person absentee ballot.

November 5, 2024: Election Day. Deadline to return an absentee ballot.

ID Requirements

Virginia law requires all voters to provide either an acceptable form of ID or sign an ID Confirmation Statement at the polls.

Polling Place Details:

Polling places are open from 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.
