Register

October 8, 2024: Regular deadline for in-person voter registration.*

October 20, 2024: Deadline for online voter registration.

*Individuals may continue to register in person at their County Clerk's Office through Election Day.

Voting

All voters have the option to vote early, either by mail or in person.

September 26, 2024: In-person early voting begins.

October 31, 2024: Deadline to request a vote-by-mail ballot by mail.

November 4, 2024: Deadline to request a vote-by-mail ballot in-person. Early voting ends.

November 5, 2024: Election Day.

ID Requirements

Identification is not required to vote at the polls in most instances, but may be required if the voter hasn't completed the voter-registration process or if the voter is registering or changing-voter registration information.

Polling Place Details

Polling places are open from 6:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.


