## Leveling the Playing Field with Tax Rates in New Mexico

The Small Business Tax Deduction allows small businesses to deduct up to 20% of their business income, providing relief for New Mexico's small business owners.

Without action from Congress, this deduction expires this year while the tax deduction for larger corporations remains.
