NFIB members to visit lawmakers, hear from State Treasurer and SBA regional leader

SACRAMENTO, Calif., Aug. 22, 2025—In advance of the Legislature’s scheduled September 12 adjournment of its 2025 session, NFIB-member small-business owners from throughout California will gather in Sacramento, Tuesday, August 26, for a day of advocacy on the remaining bills helpful and harmful to Main Street enterprises.

The select group of small business owners are members of NFIB California’s Leadership Council. The group will gather in the old Senator Hotel, 1121 L Street, to hear morning presentations, starting at 9 a.m., from State Treasurer Fiona Ma, SBA Sacramento District Director Heather Luzzi, Sen. Brian Jones, and Assemblymember Diane Dixon. After lunch, they will meet with a bipartisan group of lawmakers in the Capitol Annex Swing Space.
